**Mirrorsail 2007**

Yachting WA in conjunction with the Mirror Class Association of WA invites you and your crew with your Mirror to Claremont Yacht Club on Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2007 for Mirrorsail 2007.

Mirrorsail is a new Yachting WA training programme, endorsed and backed by the Mirror Class Association of Western Australia. This year it is being hosted and supported by Claremont Yacht Club. The programme is for all Mirror sailors who have completed a 'learn to sail' course or have some level of racing experience. Adult/child crew combinations are invited to participate. The programme is designed to develop the sailing and racing skills of sailors in a fun, safe and social environment participating in a large training programme.

The fleet will be graded according to skill levels and appropriate coaches will be provided for each group. Please indicate your appropriate level on the registration form.

To aid with the planning and organisation of this training programme we ask that you complete and return the attached form together with your payment ASAP to Yachting WA. Applications must be received by the **close of business on the 24 August 2007** to ensure you place on the programme.

The cost for Mirrorsail is excellent value at \$99.00 (Inc. GST) per sailor. Cost includes quality coaching throughout the two days, lunch both days, dinner Saturday night and course notes. Sailors between the ages of 8 and 16 (inclusive) are invited to camp overnight in the CYC clubhouse with breakfast provided. For all participants there will be a dinner provided on Saturday night.

For those sailors sleeping over you will need a sleeping bag, sleeping mat, sleeping wear, changes of clothes (things may not dry overnight), foot wear, towels and toiletries. The sleepover will be fully supervised and we will use the downstairs area of the club house.

You are reminded that you will need to provide your own boat and sailing equipment. A small number of charter boats may be made available, with priority given to country participants. The cost for charter will be \$50 with a damages bond of \$100.

To accept your invitation, please check that the application form is complete and payment is enclosed and return it to Yachting WA.
